The Farm School of Life Science Summer Day Camp June, 2010

The Farm School of Life Science at Crowe's Nest Farm embraces the goal of teaching every child who visits our facilities to respect the great outdoors of Texas. During summer day camp, we want to provide an environment where science is not considered work, but pleasure. Children will be **doing** science, not reading about it in a textbook. Although this experience is not possible in a regular classroom setting, it is possible at the farm with over 100 acres to roam and explore.

It is our wish to instill a conservation ethic among children by connecting them with the land and all of its inhabitants. This will be accomplished by providing in-depth, hands-on activities relating to various life-science studies including: botany, animal husbandry, ornithology, herpetology, entomology, pond study, and gardening. ***Farm Animals and Native Texas Wildlife will be a combined study for the week.***

Young Farmers Half-Day Camp 9:00 – 1:00 (entering Kindergarten – entering 2nd grade) Fee: \$175.

Children entering kindergarten thru second grade can participate in a half-day camp program learning about farm animals & Texas Wildlife.

Explorers Half-Day Camp 9:00 – 1:00 (entering 3rd – entering 5th grade) Fee: \$175.

Students will enjoy fun-filled life-science activities as they explore fields, ponds, woods, and lots of animals. Students will learn and interact with farm animals & Texas wildlife. See below for study topics.

** Students will need to bring a sack lunch except on Friday when a cowboy cookout lunch will be provided. Snacks and drinks will be provided.*

Session II- June 28 - July 2: Farm & Wildlife Study

Topics include: Farm animals and products; animal husbandry; gardening; insects; native Texas wildlife; reptiles & amphibians; raptors; pond study; farm chores
